Eagan Foundation honors local students

Eagan, Minnesota – Seventy-two high school seniors are recipients of the 2011 Eagan Foundation scholarships totaling nearly \$60,000. The winners will be honored at a breakfast presentation on Tuesday, May 17 at Eagan High School.

“These awards really make a difference in the lives of the students,” said Patti Engel, chair, Eagan Foundation, “The support helps to relieve some of the financial burden with school expenses so students can focus on their studies and have a successful first year.”

Over the past 20 years, the Eagan Foundation has awarded more than \$800,000 in scholarships to area students through the generous contributions from many local businesses, school organizations, family foundations and nonprofits. “Many of the scholarship recipients have said that being recognized by members of their community makes the Eagan Foundation award especially meaningful,” said Engel.

To be eligible, students must be seniors who live within the City of Eagan or attend school in Eagan, and plan on furthering their education at a technical school, college, or university.
