About The Eagan Foundation:

The Eagan Foundation is a nonprofit community-building organization whose mission it is to make Eagan the best place to live, learn, work, and play. The Eagan Foundation was founded in 1990 and encourages, supports and enhances ideas, funding and collaborative action to meet community needs. To date, the Foundation has raised and reinvested over \$500,000 in the community through its scholarship, community initiatives and community grants programs.

Scholarship Program

Since 1991, the Eagan Foundation has sponsored a successful annual scholarship program and has awarded scholarships to hundreds of high school graduates who reside in or attend school in Eagan. Each year the number of scholarships awarded increases helping meet the increasing needs of deserving students in their pursuit of a higher education.

Community Initiatives

The Foundation has been involved in a number of other community initiatives such as the building of the Eagan Civic Arena, the “Forever Green” tree planting project and the Eagan Flood Relief program. Additionally, the Foundation, its generous contributors and volunteers, and the City of Eagan moved the “Grandfather Tree” to its current location at the entrance of the Eagan Community Center.

Fiduciary Agent Program

The Eagan Foundation is available to serve as the fiscal agent for charitable community groups who do not yet have IRS 501(c)(3) tax exempt status.

Community Grants

The Foundation has awarded grants to community organizations in the past. Award recipients have included:

- Dakota Woodlands: a short term housing facility for homeless women and children located in Eagan
- Eagan Resource Center: a food shelf and education resource center located at Mount Calvary Church in Eagan
- Cheerful Givers: a nonprofit organization based in Eagan

- that provides toy-filled birthday gift bags to food shelves and shelters
- Caponi Art Park: a 60-acre outdoor sculpture garden and center for performing arts
- Eagan Women of Note: a community based choir made up of women of all ages
- Eagan High School Robotics Team: encouraging future engineers and improving science and technology education
- Minnesota Festival of Trees Educational Scavenger Hunt : Eagan high school students worked in conjunction with the Foundation to support the City of Eagan’s efforts for this statewide event

Each year the Foundation holds its major fundraising effort of the year - the Wine Tasting and Silent Auction Gala at the Eagan Community Center.
