Eagan Foundation awards \$100,000 in scholarships to local students

(Eagan, MN, 5/22/13) – The Eagan Foundation has honored 118 graduating high school students from Eagan with \$100,000 in scholarships – the largest annual number and amount awarded in the 23-year history of the Foundation. This year's awards also represent a milestone for the Eagan Foundation – it is the first year over 100 scholarships have been awarded, thanks to the generous support of new donors and the continued dedication of longtime donors who have increased their contribution. Scholarships are funded by many local businesses, school organizations, family foundations, and nonprofits. The scholarship winners were honored at a breakfast presentation on May 21 at Eagan High School.

Senior-year students attending Eagan High School or residing in Eagan were eligible for the scholarships administered through the Eagan Foundation's 2013 Scholarship Program. 25 new scholarships were added for a total of \$25,900 more than last year's offerings. To be eligible, senior students had to first meet two main criteria: 1) live within the City of Eagan or attend Eagan High School, and 2) plan on furthering their education at a technical school, college, or university. Scholarships were then awarded based on a variety of donor-specified criteria such as academic achievement, student financial need, or career interest.

"I congratulate all of the scholarship recipients who have worked hard and have earned the recognition of the Eagan community," said Michael Proebstle, board and scholarship chair of the Eagan Foundation. "It is an honor to be able to award scholarships to such a distinguished group of individuals."

The Eagan Foundation will seek to sustain \$100,000 in awards annually, which would result in the Foundation surpassing \$1,000,000 awarded for the first time in the organization's history in 2014. "We have made great progress in our 'Climb to One Million' campaign," said Proebstle, "We are grateful for the Eagan community's ongoing support." After this year's successful scholarship program, the Foundation will have awarded nearly \$985,000 to Eagan students in its 22-year history.
