Eagan Foundation awards \$136,450 in scholarships to local graduating high school seniors

Eagan, MN — On the evening of April 19th, the Eagan Foundation awarded scholarships to 116 outstanding Eagan-area graduating high school seniors. The recipients received their awards from Eagan's Mayor Mike Maguire at a 7:00 pm ceremony and dessert social in the Eagan High School Commons.

This year's \$136,450 in scholarships pushes the Foundation well past \$2 million in total giving since its inception in 1991. "Helping match the goodwill of Eagan donors with the sincere gratitude of worthy scholarship recipients is a great honor for our organization" says Executive Director Jamie Hopkins. Thanks to generous donors, the Foundation has come far since 1991, when it offered its first round of scholarships totaling \$4,350. Sixty donors representing area businesses, school organizations, family foundations, and nonprofits make these scholarships possible.

Extra honor was placed this year on the Foundation's four memorial scholarships: Carter Weber Memorial, Matt Thuente Memorial, Pat O'Keefe, and the Maggie Elliott "Living the Mission" Scholarship which honors EHS volleyball players that show a high level of community service. Hopkins continues, "as all scholarships are selected in a blind process, learning that EHS student Elise Elliott received the scholarship named in honor of her deceased older sister Maggie was an especially tender moment."

High school seniors living or attending school in Eagan were eligible for the scholarships, awarded based on a variety of donor-specified criteria such as academics, financial need, or career interest.
