“Our board is extremely excited about this new event, because awarding and administering scholarships to senior-year students attending Eagan High School or residing in Eagan is a big part of the Foundation’s mission,” said Michael Proebstle, Foundation scholarship chair and in-coming 2012-2013 board chair. “Last school year, we awarded 93 students with scholarships and kicked off our ‘Climb 2 One Million’ Challenge. ‘Climb 2 One Million’ aims to sustain \$100,000 in scholarship awards annually, which would result in the Eagan Foundation surpassing the \$1,000,000 mark in scholarships distributed for the first time in its history.”
